
1. How satisfied are you with your educational experience at the JPC?



2. How satisfied are you with the course selection at the JPC?








9. How satisfied are you with the employability options of the courses offered at the JPC ?






Fig: 1 Flow Chart of Process




Fig 3: Pie Chart




Fig: 1 Flow Chart of Process




Fig 3: Pie Chart
