




Substance Abuse and Illegal Trafficking Day








Essay Competition








Kargil Victory Day Celebration






Debate competition








One Day Camp


CORONA WARRIORS




center boy. 32 cadets did the ceremonial drill. 2 cadets were selected as pilot.
